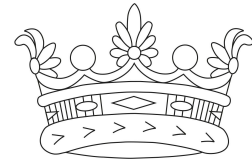
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Hand & Lock team up with Bella Lane to teach their first ever Peruvian Embroidery Class

Hand & Lock, the British embroidery house founded in 1767, have joined forces with the Peruvian embroidery artist, Bella Lane to offer their first ever embroidery class in Peru. The class will be taught in English and Spanish and take place in the thriving capital city of Lima.

12 students will take up residence at the Instituto de Modas, Arte & Diseño, Peru's main fashion school, for five days of intensive embroidery training. This essential introduction to goldwork hand embroidery will run from 22nd - 26th June 2020.

Embroidery teacher, Bella Lane was born and raised in the heart of the Peruvian Amazon rainforest, before moving to London where she received a full time scholarship as an embroidery Apprentice at the Royal School of Needlework. Lane's partnership with Hand & Lock is an exciting opportunity to combine the company's ancient craft with Lane's contemporary artistic design.

Hand & Lock have been providing exquisite embroidery to the fashion industry, Royal family and the tailors of Savile Row for over 250 years. In 2019 they were awarded the Royal Warrant for embroidery service for HRH Queen Elizabeth II. The company has taught classes across the UK, Australia, the US and now Peru.
